Over 25 years later, we are still dedicated to Chip's vision of making unique blends. In this spirit, we have created this exciting blend of Pinot Noir grapes from carefully selected vineyards from the most esteemed corners of Sonoma County, including the Russian River Valley and the Carneros regions, each offering its own unique flavor profiles from its *terroir*. The select lots of wine were blended to develop complexity and true varietal character, while retaining an approachable, rich fruit style that is genuinely delightful and truly satisfying.

The 2010 Lyeth Pinot Noir is round and supple with juicy flavors of Bing cherry and strawberry, balanced with a hint of subtle earthiness and notes of rich spice. Smooth with soft tannins, this wine perfectly complements a roasted rack of lamb.
