In 1981, Lyeth Estate was founded in Sonoma County by Chip Lyeth. After having traveled through Bordeaux in the late 1970s, Chip came to believe what the Bordelais had known for centuries: that through blending, you could create a beautiful, distinctive wine, with unique characteristics often very different from the varietals from which it is created. To craft these wines, he brought on his close friend, Bill Arbios.

The wine...

Sonoma County is one of California's most prestigious and historic wine-producing regions. The grapes used in our 2011 L de Lyeth Chardonnay were sourced from some of the finest Chardonnay vineyards in Sonoma County. With warm afternoons and cool evenings, the climate is perfectly suited for growing premium Chardonnay grapes.

Floral and bright fruit aromas are accented by rich flavors of Granny Smith apple, pear and fresh melon. This is a crisp wine with excellent texture, balanced acidity and creamy traces of vanilla that culminate in a long, buttery smooth finish. Try this wine with roasted chicken or Dungeness crab.
