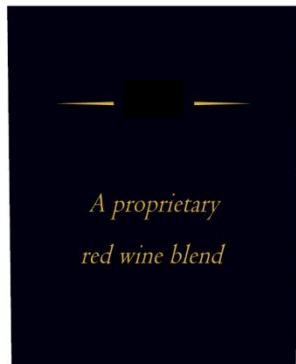

A Long Tradition

In 1981, Lyeth Estate was founded in Sonoma County by Chip Lyeth. After having traveled through Bordeaux in the late 1970s, Chip came to believe what the Bordelais had known for centuries: that through blending, you could create a beautiful, distinctive wine, with unique characteristics often very different from the varietals from which it is created. To craft these wines, he brought on his close friend, Bill Arbios. Over 25 years later, Winemaker Bill Arbios continues his dedication to Chip's vision of making unique blends from various varietals.

A New Tradition

The first California red wine blend in Lyeth's history, Fleur de Lyeth remains true to Lyeth's roots of exceptional blends with consistently high quality at a tremendous value. Winemaker Bill Arbios has crafted a California appellation wine with the sophistication and traditional elegance of Lyeth wines, holding true to Lyeth's mission of blending style, family, tradition and value.

Tasting Notes

Fleur de Lyeth's proprietary blend of Tannat, Cabernet Franc and Merlot is crafted in the noble winemaking tradition of unifying the best characteristics of multiple grape varieties to produce a harmonious wine with balanced complexity. Lyeth has been a pioneer in the art of blending wines in California since 1981 and the elegant Fleur de Lyeth honors Lyeth's long heritage with this lush wine. Well balanced, the wine coats the palate with rich flavors of blueberry and plum accented by subtle red fruit notes of strawberry and Bing cherry. With a medium body, firm tannins and a long finish, the 2011 Fleur de Lyeth pairs excellently with a grilled burger or hearty pasta.
