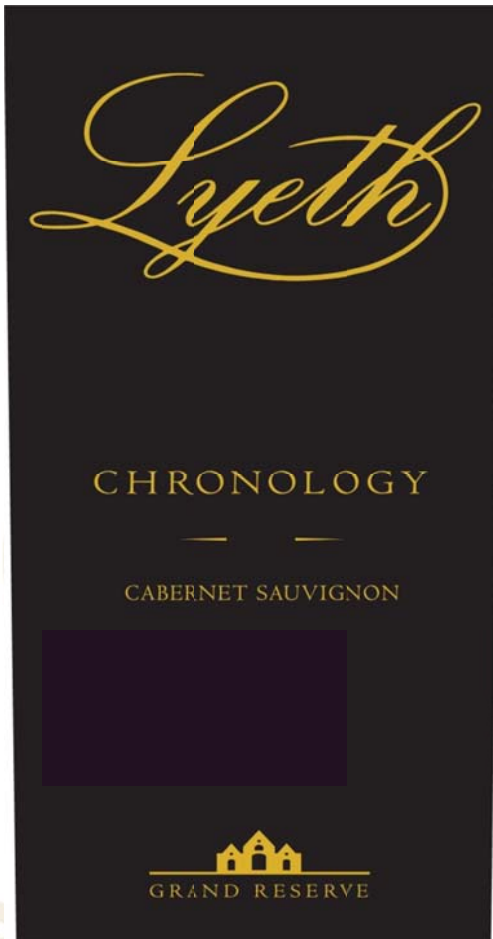

Lyeth was founded in 1981 by Chip Lyeth after traveling extensively in his quest for exceptional wines of the world. In his search, Chip fell in love with Cabernet Sauvignon, and quickly learned that blending in other varietals added layers of complexity to the overall wine.

CHRONOLOGY is the link between the past and the future, with Chip's reverence for Cabernet Sauvignon providing the foundation, and the evolution in style providing a glimpse into the future.

The wine...

The red fruit aromatics of this wine are complemented by hints of spice and perfume on the nose. Enticing flavors of brown sugar and crème brulee accent a soft mid-palate while structured tannins and a long finish make this balanced wine perfect to serve with Filet Mignon.
