AGING

The wine was aged for 12 months on 100% new French oak, which adds depth, richness, complexity, and a smooth, velvety mouthfeel.

TASTING NOTES

Our Cabernet Sauvignon is dark and daring, with bold flavors of blackberry, plum, and chocolate, complemented by the warm spice, and complexity of new French oak. The rich texture and structured tannins lead to a long, balanced and rewarding finish.

WINEMAKER

Our Director of Winemaking Nicole Walsh has spent decades crafting exceptional wines earning numerous 90+ scores along the way. Nicole and her team bring passion and expertise to every bottle, creating bold and memorable award winning wines.

VINTAGE

This growing season began with ideal weather, followed by an extended heat event in late August that accelerated the harvest, reducing yields in some varieties. This resulted in wines with great concentration, color, and depth, showcasing the best of the season.

Our bold Cabernet pairs beautifully with robust dishes like grilled steaks, braised short ribs, or spicy lamb chops. The rich tannins also complement aged cheeses and gourmet burgers, making it the perfect companion for bold flavors.
